Delivery Period

For 'In Stock Items' (items starting with code ISI) our processing time is 7-10 working days. Made to Order (MTO) items are manufactured to order and is normally dispatched within 6-8 weeks. Please allow for additional 5-7 days for the branding/embroidery of items, where applicable. We unfortunately cannot expedite orders. Note that confirmed orders are processed in date order, not according to order size. Depending on the size of our production queue, and especially during peak periods (July to December) delivery periods may be extended.

Occasionally an *ISI item or a specific fabric may be temporarily out of stock. We will notify you of the situation and provide the option of selecting a substitute item or placing it on back order. We will give you an indication of when you can expect to receive the goods.

Embroidery Service

We offer a high quality embroidery service, which allows you to personalise your uniforms to suit your individual needs. Using the best equipment, we can embroider your company logo for a reasonable cost. For this service and a free quotation, please provide us with a clear colour copy of your design in .jpg format.

Payment

Order confirmation deposit of 60% is payable on placement of the order and before the order is processed. The balance becomes due once the order is packed and ready for dispatch. We will inform you via email regarding the status of your order. Once the final payment reflects on our bank statement the merchandise is released for dispatch/collection. Please note our prices exclude VAT, delivery cost to the preferred destination and related insurance, cross-border duties and embroidery/branding cost. Prices may change without prior notice due to fluctuation of the exchange rate, unforeseen increases in material costs and labour costs. Please contact us for a current price list.





Delivery of Orders

Orders are delivered by reputable door-to-door courier service. Delivery times vary depending on destination, however most orders are delivered within 2-4 days from leaving our warehouse. We supply and deliver to cross-border countries and other Africa destinations. Cost and delivery time frames vary per country and will be provided on request. Please note we do not make use of postal services under any circumstances. Orders may be collected from our warehouse in Johannesburg. Please refer to the current price list for transport costs.

Uniform Samples

Catalogue items can be viewed at our factory in Johannesburg. Alternatively contact us with your requirements and we can make arrangements to send them to you via courier service. Samples are charged at the full price plus delivery cost, and is payable in full prior to dispatch. A full refund will be given provided the items are returned within 7 days from receipt, unused and in the original condition and packaging. Refunds are forfeited when the garments are not returned during the specified time and/or not in the condition they were provided.

Due to the volume of requests, administration time and delivery costs involved, we unfortunately cannot supply free samples.

Our sample range consist of all items displayed in our catalogue, female sizes 32/S and male sizes 38/M. We strive to accommodate all requests to the best of our abilities but it is not feasible for us to have every style in every colour and every size on hand. Although we will endeavour to accommodate your specific request, we cannot guarantee that a requested colour or size would be provided. The requested item may already be on loan to one of our clients or we simply do not have a sample of the specific item. If we do not have a garment in the exact colour that you have requested we will try to provide a similar garment for you to view.

Requests for samples must be submitted via the email address shown at the bottom of the following page. Provide us with a list of items you would like to see including the item codes and colours.

Please include your company name, VAT number, Postal-and delivery address and contact number. We will contact you promptly if we need additional information.

Minimum Order

For your first order, there is a minimum requirement of 12 garments on *ISI items, and 24 garments on *MTO items. For subsequent orders a minimum of 3 garments apply.

Exchange Policy

If for any reason you are not satisfied with your purchase, we will gladly process an exchange. Items may be exchanged as long as they have not been made to special order, are not custom made, not personalised/embroidered, not been worn, washed or altered in any way, are still in the original packaging and fit to be returned to stock. Please note exchanges will not be accepted unless the items and packaging are returned in perfect condition within 14 days of supply. Items not returned during the specified time frame and/or items which do not conform to the above criteria cannot be accepted and will be returned to you. Exchanges are subject to a 20% handling fee. Items can only be returned for exchange, not refund. Please submit your request for an exchange within 5 days from receipt of order via the email address shown at the bottom of the following page. Please allow up to14 working days for *ISI exchanges to be processed once they reach our warehouse, and 3-5 weeks for *MTO exchanges.

Clothing Africa produces and sources garments to strict quality guidelines, therefore should you receive a faulty item, please call or email us within 5 days from supply to arrange an exchange. Defect items must be returned within 14 days.

Faulty items include defects in workmanship or fabric, or error due to oversight on our part.





Size Guide

*MTO garments are developed and produced in accordance with strict fit and quality guidelines. We strive to deliver great fitting garments with consistency in sizing. Please refer to our Size Guide to determine the correct sizes to order and to review tips for measuring. The majority of our ladies garments are offered in sizes 28-54. Sizes 28-42 are at the standard catalogue price. Sizes 44-54 are subject to size surcharges. All lengths specified are approximate and can vary slightly.

Alterations

Our business is the supply and bulk production of standard sized uniforms. We do not provide tailoring- or alteration services.

Cancellation / Amendment to Orders

All orders are processed immediately, which means that we are most of the time unable to amend or cancel orders once they have been received, so please do make sure you are happy with your order before placing it. If you require additional items, you can place a new order. Orders once delivered may not be cancelled and are non-refundable.

Packaging & Uniform Distribution

Uniforms are being delivered pre-packed per individual staff member and according to department for easy distribution. Parcels are labeled with employee's name, department and quantity garments ordered and packed. A delivery note accompanies all consignments which indicates the quantity of uniforms being delivered.







Garment Care

Most of our garments are hand- or machine washable. However to ensure a long garment life we do recommend that all lined jackets and sleeveless jackets be professionally dry-cleaned. All garments are labelled with care instructions and includes a spare button. Additional buttons for *MTO items are available at minimal cost, remember to add these to your order.

Custom designed uniforms

While our catalogue product line is very extensive, we do at times receive requests for custom designed uniforms. In the event that we accept such a project, a minimum order amount applies. Over and above garment cost, the following charges will apply: storyboard costs, personalisation costs, design fees, pattern drafting fees and custom made sample cost. The client must be prepared to carry fabric stock to ensure availability for subsequent orders. We reserve the right to decline a request for custom designed uniforms.

How to place an order

We accept orders by fax or email. Orders can be summarised on an Excel spreadsheet and attached to your email. Your order should include the item code of the garments, colour, sizes and the quantity you wish to order. Please do not forget to include your company name, postal and delivery address, VAT- and contact numbers. For your convenience we have included in this catalogue Employee Measurements Sheets which will assist in establishing ordering sizes once staff members have been measured.

We do not offer online ordering at this time. Our uniforms are sold only to the end-user and may not be resold. In order to maintain direct contact with our clients we do not make use of sales agents or consultants. Our operations are based in Johannesburg from where we gladly assist with any enquiries.

Peak time production

As from August each year we receive high volume orders from large accounts for delivery prior to our annual December leave period. In order for us to plan our production and to execute orders received, any order received after the 3rd week in October will fall in gueue for production in the new year. We therefore urge you to kindly place your orders timeously in order to avoid disappointment.

How To Measure For The Right Size

- Ensure body measurements are taken over as few clothes as possible and that these garments do not seriously affect the body shape or interfere with the taking of accurate measurements.
- Do not make provision for the wearing ease of a garment.
- The measuring tape must be held firm.
- Ensure all pockets are emptied before measuring.
- Take the same measurement at least twice in order to confirm your original measurement - this is important!

FEMALE

- 1. Bust measurement Wrap the tape around your back and bring it to the front, under the armpits to the fullest part of your bust. Your arms should be relaxed, hanging down at your sides. (fig 2a)
- 2. Natural waist measurement This measurement should be taken around the smallest part of your torso, also known as the natural waistline. Typically, it is 3cm or so above your belly button. The abdomen must be relaxed when this measurement is taken. (fig 2b)
- 3. Abdomen measurement This measurement is only needed when you have a protruding abdomen (tummy). Take this measurement approximately 7cm below the natural waistline. (fig 2c)
- 4. Hip measurement is taken round the buttocks, approximately 18-23cm below the natural waistline. Stand with your feet together. (fig 2d)
- 5. High thigh is measured around the widest part of the upper thigh. (fig 2e)



Measurement & Sizing Tips

MALE

- . Neck measurement The girth of the neck is measured by putting the tape measure around the neck at the base of the neck just below the Adam's apple. (fig 1a).
- 2. Chest measurement put the tape measure around the chest, over the shoulder blades, under the armpits and across the front chest. It is easier to take this measurement from the back. (fig 1b)
- 3. Natural waist / abdomen (protruding tummy) This measurement is different from the trouser measurement in that it should be taken at or just above the belly button. The abdomen must be relaxed when this measurement is taken. (fig 1c)
- 4. Trouser waist is measured at the level you prefer to have your belt. This measurement is usually where the trouser waistband sits at the top of the hips. Measure around the exact level where you wear your belt. Hold the tape measure tight with one finger on the inside. (fig 1d)

Other measurements:

- Hats Head measurement is taken around the widest part of the head above the ears.
- Belts We recommend ordering one size larger than your waist size, for example if you have a 32 trouser, order a size 34 belt.
- Gloves Measure around the knuckles where the fingers join the hand. Provide us with this measurement.

Measuring & Sizing Tips

Female

1. Female employees should wear the same brassiere which they would usually wear. Measuring over a padded brassiere will provide





- slim waist and wider hips.

- /dress (torso garments only).
- (*MTO styles only).

Male

- for jackets and waistcoat.

3. Jackets - For a person with broad/wide shoulders, order one or two



a larger measurement oppose to true bust measurement. The padded brassiere measurement will result in ordering one size larger and the garment may appear too big when wearing a non-padded

2. In order to accommodate various shaped figures, ladies skirts and trousers are designed on hip measurement, not waist measurement. Confirmation of the correct size is when the garment fits comfortably over the hip area. When the skirt/trouser fits the hip but the waist is too large, it means the lady is pear-shaped and the garment needs to be altered at the waist - pear shaped women have

3. The hip measurement is not necessarily the widest part of the lower torso. For this reason it is vital to take the tummy-, hip- and high thigh measurement. The largest measurement of the three is to be used to determine correct ordering size for skirts and trousers. These measurements applies to plus size ladies in particular.

4. In order for ladies' trousers to fully cover and fit comfortably over the buttocks, we recommend ordering our trouser with elastic back (MTO/13/109F) which has been designed specifically for this purpose.

5. Ladies who's measurements indicate much larger hip size compared to bust size should order one size up to accommodate for the hip size, e.g. 34 bust size & 40 hip size should order size 36 blouse/jacket

6. We can accommodate longer or shorter sleeve- and trouser lengths for tall/short ladies – indicate 'Short' or 'Tall' when ordering

1. Shirt size - for formal shirts (when a tie is to be worn) the neck measurement determines the ordering size. For informal shirt the chest measurement determines ordering size. Where the person has a large protruding tummy, order according to this measurement oppose to chest measurement to ensure a comfortable fit.

2. Jackets and waistcoats – The chest and natural waist/ tummy measurements are essential to establish which level has the largest circumference - when the natural waist/tummy measurement is 5cm larger than the chest measurement this measurement instead of chest measurement is used to determine the correct ordering size

sizes larger than the size you would have selected based on chest size, e.g. chest measurement indicates you should order size 40, but due to broad shoulders size 42 will provide a more suitable fit.

- 4. What size are suit trouser? The difference between jacket and trouser is 15cm (6 inches). For example if you are a 40 chest, you will receive a 34 trouser. When you are a 40 chest but wear a 36 trouser, we recommend ordering our Suit Separates.
- 5. To confirm that you have ordered the correct trouser size, use the following tips on men's sizing ratios:
- Average built: Chest size less 15cm (6 inches) = trouser measurement / trouser waistband measurement + 15cm (6 inches) = chest measurement, e.g. 38 jacket & waistcoat = 32 trouser size
- Portly built: Chest size less 10cm (4 inches) = trouser measurement / trouser waistband measurement + 10cm (4 inches)
- Athletic: Chest size less 20cm (8 inches) = trouser measurement / trouser waistband measurement + 20cm (8 inches) = chest measurement, e.g. 42 jacket & waistcoat = 34 trouser size

General

- Once the measurements of each employee have been obtained, use the Size Guide to find the correct sizes.
- Bone structure and personal preference (close- or loose fitting) garments) must be taken into consideration where a person is in-between two sizes.
- When unsure, order the larger size.
- All lengths specified in our catalogue are approximate and can vary slightly. The trouser length measurement is taken from the base of the waistband, along the outside of the leg to the hem. The skirt length measurement is taken from the base of the waistband to the finished hem.
- Our garments have been designed to accommodate most figures. Despite our best efforts a disproportionate figure's uniform might need minor adjustments to ensure a suitable fit. Ask your in-house seamstress or professional alteration service to assist.

Payment

Orders are payable in full before they are dispatched. Confirmation deposit of 60% is payable on placement of orders, the balance amount is due before dispatch. The Purchaser is not entitled to attach any condition to any balance or outstanding payment. All sales are final. Once placed, orders may not be cancelled or changed. Ownership of goods shall remain vested in Clothing Africa until the purchase price has been paid in full. Should the Purchaser fail to pay any outstanding amount on the due date, we reserve the right to suspend or cancel future deliveries.

Force Majeure

Guarantee

Clothing Africa guarantees all products to be free from manufacturing defects and will replace any garment found to be defective provided that the Purchaser shall within five (5) days from receipt of goods give notice to us that the goods are not in accordance with the contract or are defective. In the event that the Purchaser establishes to his reasonable satisfaction that the goods are not in accordance with the contract, or are so defective the sole remedy in respect of such non-accordance or defects shall be limited to the return of the goods within fourteen (14) days from receipt of goods, and the merchandise shall be accordingly replaced. We reserve the right to make a final determination as to whether or not a product is defective. If the Purchaser fails to give notice within five (5) days the goods shall be conclusively presumed to be in accordance with the contract and free from defect and the Purchaser shall be deemed to have accepted the goods accordingly.

10 Returns
